Anna Egan Smucker is an award-winning author of nine books. *No Star Nights*, her memoir about growing up in the steel mill town of Weirton, WV won the International Reading Association Children's Book Award. *Golden Delicious: A Cinderella Apple Story* and *Brother Giovanni's Little Reward: How the Pretzel Was Born* represented WV at National Book Festivals in D.C. *Fallingwater: The Building of Frank Lloyd Wright's Masterpiece*, co-authored with Marc Harshman, garnered starred reviews and was named an Amazon Nonfiction Book of the Month. Recipient of a WV Arts Commission Artist Fellowship Award, her poems have been published in anthologies and literary journals. Her first chapbook, titled *Rowing Home*, was published in 2019 by Finishing Line Press. Anna makes her home in Bridgeport, West Virginia.
